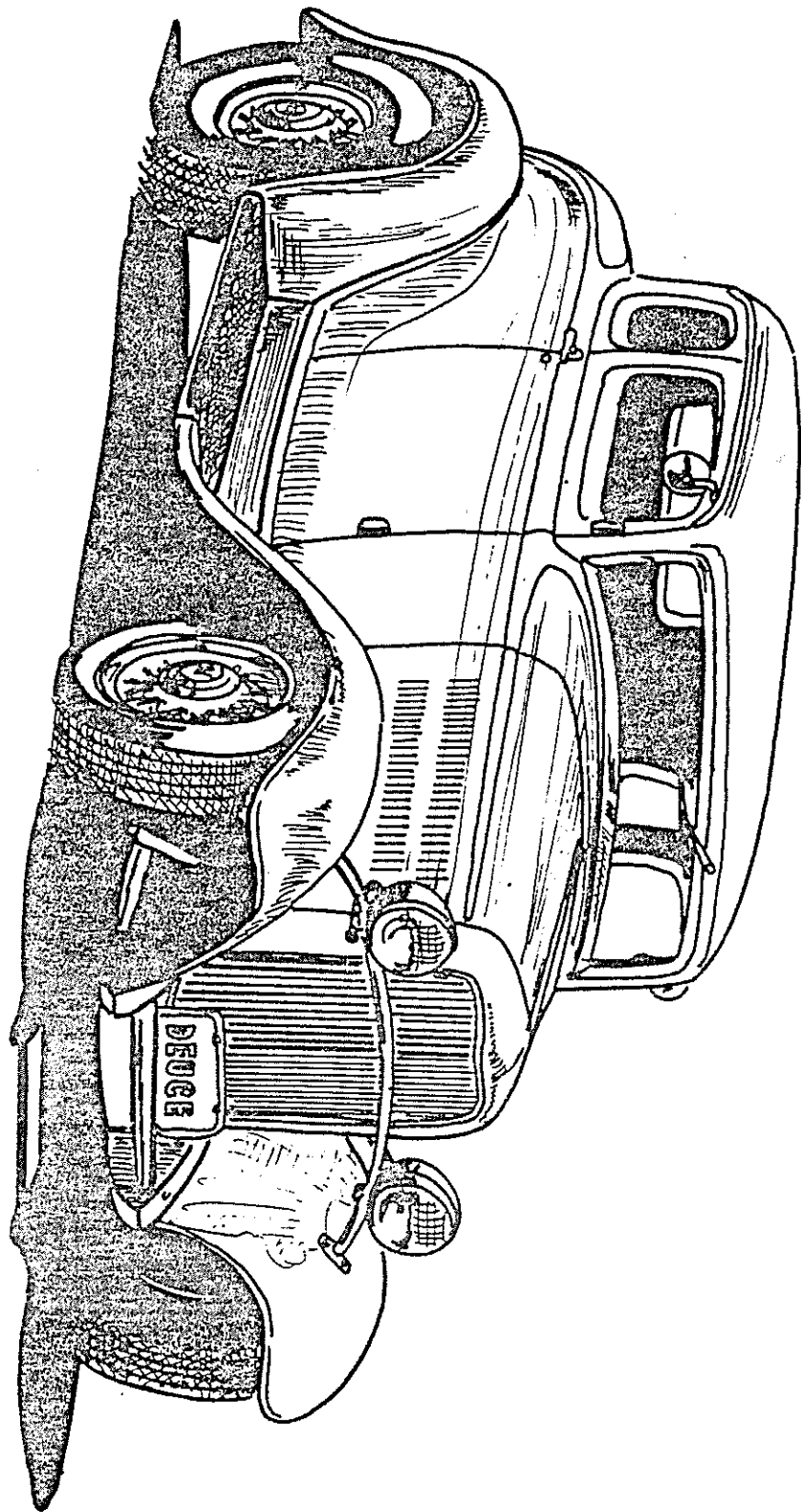
The Kings have said that things have changed and that they will probably be able to fly to Oklahoma City -- it will be great to have a representative from our sister city in the North.
