--SAFETY NEWS--

Well, it has been a busy two months for the safety inspection team. Following is a rundown on what's been happening.

At the 2nd Annual World of Wheels, held at the Alaska Sales and Service Building, on April 8th and 9th, the safety inspection crew, Tom Snyder and myself inspected four rods. Harold Rounds' "new" '32 Bantam roadster passed following correction of a minor brake leak. Likewise Bernie Edwards' chopped '34 Ford Sedan passed after repair of a brake fitting leak. Both of these rods are freshly built and the craftsmanship and attention to detail is readily apparent.

Also inspected was local club Secretary John LaFournaise's '69 Road Runner. John's car passed without difficulty as his car is virtually stock, very clean and well maintained. Hector Cortez's '23 T-bucket was given a "courtesy inspection" to help him in correcting some safety violations. Hector's car is a great example of a home-built rod full of many low-buck ideas.

On April 24, Ross Jardine's car was inspected in his garage. Ross recently installed a Mustang 11 front end and windshield wipers on his '36 Ford five window coupe. Ross has constructed many rods thru the years and this is one fine example of his workmanship. Needless to say his car passed without problems.

Both Bernie Edwards and Ross Jardine have recently joined Tom and I on the safety inspection team. These two members bring a wealth of experience to the safety team and Tom and I look forward to working with them.

On May 14th and 15th, the first Annual World of Wheels was held in Fairbanks at the Tanana Valley Fairgrounds under the superb direction of Dean King. The entire inspection team traveled to Fairbanks and inspected seven local cars. Those inspected were Gary Selisker's '57 Chevy hardtop, Rolf Mey's '67 Camaro, Dean King's '29 Chevy coupe, Sid Miller's '57 Chevy hardtop, Tyrone Oates' '77 Corvette, Bill Simmons' '56 Nomad, and Eddie Brown's '57 Corvette.

Both Dean King's coupe and Bill Simmons' Nomad passed without difficulty. The remaining rods inspected required minor safety violation corrections including steering wheel excessive play, fuel line rerouting, license plate light installation, bald tire replacement, and windshield wiper/motor installation. With little work these cars should all pass in the future without difficulty.

I think I speak for the entire team that the quality of the cars inspected was first rate and the cooperation of the Fairbanks group was greatly appreciated. A special thanks to Sid Miller for the loan of a floor jack and jack stands. We look forward to seeing the Fairbanks folks again during Golden Days in July.

As you can see it has been a busy two months. The team has inspected eleven cars and passed five. Two new inspectors have joined the team. Future inspections are slated for the Show and Shine, Anchorage, and Golden Days, Fairbanks. I would also like to hear from the Last Frontier club in regards to setting up an inspection for their club members cars.

Now if I can just get the needed forms and paperwork from those folks back at NSRA headquarters.....!!!!!!
