## HOT RODS COMES TO ANCHORAGE

A new night club came to Anchorage last month that will knock the socks off any nostalgia buff. HOT RODS, located above the Billiard Palace on Old Seward Highway has the best decor of any place I've seen. As you walk up the stairs to the second floor night club, there is the right side sliced from bumper to bumper of a '59 Caddy Convertible. It is complemented by posters of street rods and other neat cars.

Once inside, you can hear the wonderful sounds of the best music in the world. That from the fifties, sixties and sometimes early seventies. The interior is mostly in black and white colors with chrome trim. The staff is dressed fifties style however the waitress have perfected the poodle skirt, it's above the knees. You could spend hours looking at the decorations. There are posters, records and wheel covers all over the place. Mounted above the bar on one end is the nose of a 1955 Chevy and the other end is a 1958 or 1959 Corvette. Each nose is complete with bumpers, headlights, grill and hood ornament. The two seats of choice are a carved out of the trunk of a 1957 Chevy and 1956 Lincoln. Both seats, er trunks, have working tail lights, bumpers and of course fins. The highlight is a yellow 1931 Ford roadster street rod. The hired help said it was a running car when parked.

In addition to the great music, there is a big screen television projecting on to the wall and on that wall is a mural of a drive in theater. You can expect to see anything from rod runs to great movies like American Graffiti. They also have about 12 dart boards and three pool tables.

If you have the munchies, they can fix you up. In addition to the typical appetizers of steak finger, hot wings, and chicken strips, they have two inch hamburgers. You can get a pair for \$1.50, a full set (4) for \$2.50 or a Six Pack for \$4.00. They also have a full selection of sandwiches and hamburgers which includes the Classy, Hot Rod (loaded) or a Convertible (open face) for only \$5.95. In fact, by the time you read this newsletter, HOT RODS will be open for lunch.

Nothing this great comes cheap. There is a \$3.00 cover charge on Friday and Saturday nights after 8 P.M. and one dollar during the week. Seems like a rip off to pay someone to buy their booze and food but at least HOT RODS has something to offer. To help get the dancing fever going, every so often the staff get on the dance floor for a neat organized routine. There's even a couple on staff that comes out every so often and when they do, they need every inch of the dance floor for their twirls, jumps, etc.

All in all, HOT RODS gets my vote for "BEST NIGHT CLUB IN THE STATE" award especially once you consider this is the only establishment in the State of Alaska with Valet parking. That's worth the \$3.00 on a cold Alaskan night.

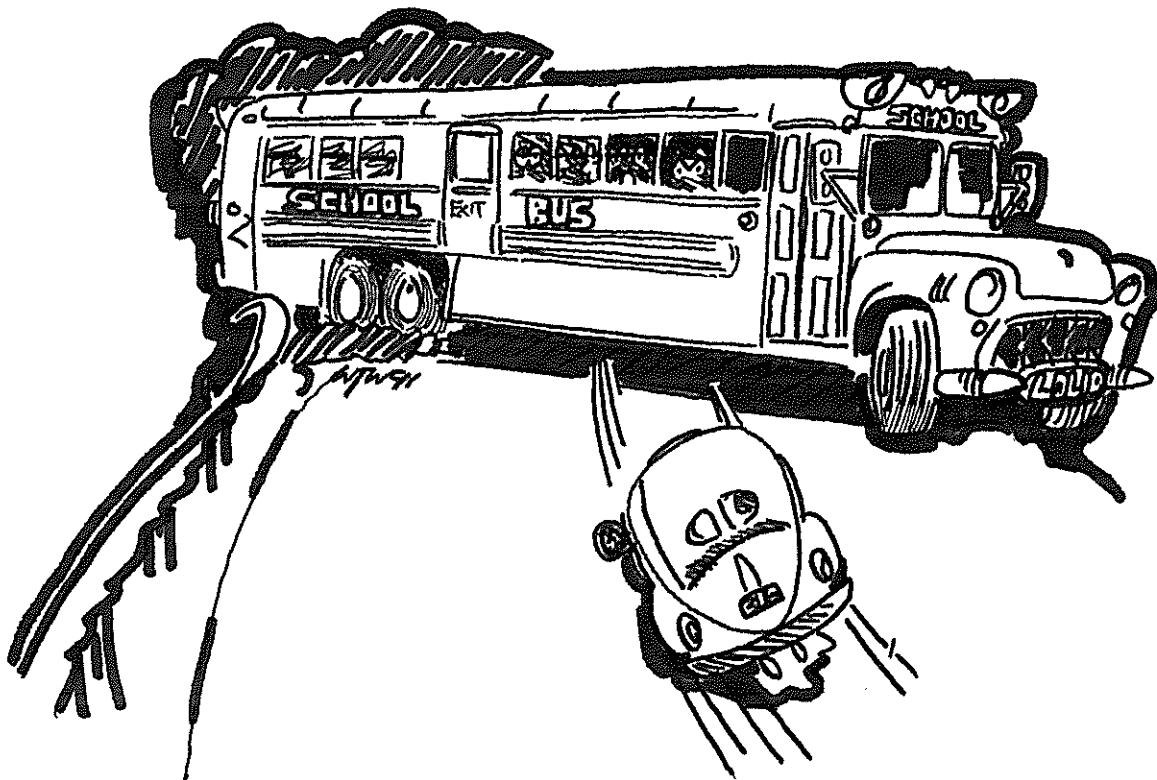
